Humble Yourself | Ronnie Hewitt

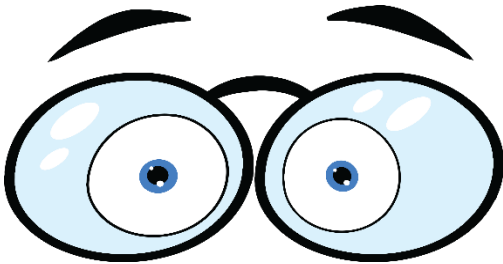
There's a song in our books we sing periodically entitled: "Humble Yourself." It says, "Humble yourself in the sight of the Lord and He will lift you up." The song comes from the passage found in 1Peter 5:5-6, "*In the same way, you who are younger, submit yourselves to your elders. All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because, God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble.* ⁶ *Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that He may lift you up in due time.*"

While contemplating this, it began sinking in more and more, the responsibility I have to humble myself. Peter used the term "*clothe yourself with humility.*" That word "clothe," in the Greek, means to attach a piece of clothing to oneself. In NT times, slaves fastened a white piece of cloth or apron over their clothing so that others would know they were slaves. Should it be any different with us who are now bond-servants (slaves to Christ by choice). Peter exhorts us to tie the cloth of humility on ourselves to 1) be identified as believers in Christ as we act humbly toward others, and 2) to receive God's grace and help (1Pet 5:5-7).

Another passage that comes to mind is Luke 14:11, "*For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.*" Here the Savior warns that those who exalt themselves in this life will be humbled. Much more important that earthly honor is our place of honor before God. Such honor cannot be secured by self-assertiveness, for it only comes through humility and servanthood.

I wonder as Peter wrote this if he thought back to Christ wrapping the towel around His waist and washing the disciples' feet (Jn 13:4-5).
