The next meeting and brunch for our ladies will be **Saturday, April 9 at 10am** in the fellowship hall. GayLee will be leading the discussion.

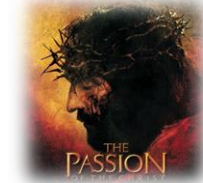
