Lonnie Hewitt saw his cardiologist and they have adjusted his meds. He will follow up again in a couple of weeks.

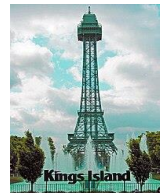
Angie Johnston, Dan Strobe's coworker, lost her mother Saturday and then her father passed away on Sunday.
